Circulatory Trace 1 question = 10 points

Lab 7 (**Nervous System I: Brain & Cranial Nerves**) = approximately 11 questions (models, wet specimens, structures, significance, functions, foramina)

Lab 8 (**Nervous System II: Spinal Cord/Nerve/Eye & Ear**) = approximately 13 questions (structures, functions)

Lab 9 (**Blood & Heart**) = approximately 7 questions (coronary circulation, histology, structures)

Lab 10 (**Vessels**) = approximately 9 questions (histology, arteries, veins) + 10 point circulatory trace

Lab 11 (**Respiratory & Digestive**) = approximately 13 questions (organs, histology)

Lab 12 (**Urinary & Reproductive**) = approximately 12 questions (structures, pathways: sperm & semen/ oocyte release)

1. Spelling/wording of answers:

- a. One letter incorrect (but doesn't change the word) - full credit
